individuals benefited from Disaster Risk Reduction trainings, community drills and distribution of preparedness equipment



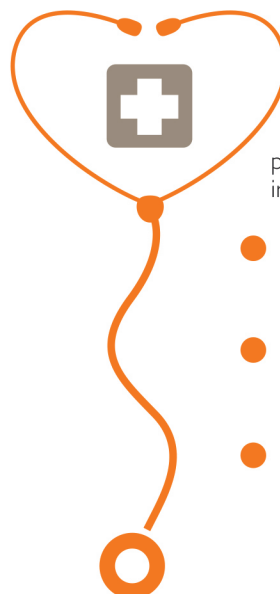
